How to Get to the Evergreen Olympia Campus
From north or south:

1. Take Interstate 5 to Olympia.
2. Turn onto Highway 101 at Exit 104.
3. Go west on 101 North for three miles.
4. Take The Evergreen State College exit.
5. Go two miles north on the Evergreen Parkway to the main campus entrance (at the roundabout).

From the west:

1. Go east on Highway 101 North toward Olympia.
2. Take the Aberdeen/Shelton exit.
3. Turn left at the stop sign onto 2nd Ave SW, which becomes Mud Bay Road.
4. Follow the road's curve to the right and continue up the hill.
5. At the hill's top, just beyond the overpass, turn left at The Evergreen State College exit.
6. Merge onto Evergreen Parkway.
7. Go two miles north to the main campus entrance (at the roundabout).
8. Drive past the main campus entrance and take the next left onto Overhulse Place.
9. When you reach Driftwood Road, turn left and travel ½ mile to parking lot F.
10. After you park, you will have a short walk to our Summer Guest Services office in residence hall A where you will check in, receive your apartment key and receive your multi-day parking permit.
11. Please display the permit on your vehicle dashboard.

Airport Transportation

Seattle-Tacoma International Airport (SeaTac) is 50 miles north of Evergreen. Shuttle service is provided by Capital Aeroporter (360) 754-7113 or (800) 962-3579 and Centralia SeaTac Express (360) 786-0636 or (800) 773-9490.

Public Transportation

InterCity Transit (IT) connects Evergreen to downtown Olympia, surrounding communities and the Amtrak rail station. Route schedules are available in the Bookstore and Summer Guest Services. Contact IT at (360) 786-1881 for more information.

Evergreen housing is unique in that it consists exclusively of apartment style suites. You won't find any rectangular buildings with long halls and closet sized bedrooms on the

campus; they offer the space, comfort, privacy and community that only apartments can provide.

Suites are 4 or 6 person units with private bedrooms, a twin-size bed, desk and chair, dresser and closet or armoire. Internet access and cable television are available in all bedrooms and common spaces. However, guests must bring their own computer or television set. Coin operated laundry facilities are available in the "A" building as well as in the Housing Community Center.

Full bed linen service for groups includes: sheets, pillow, pillowcase, blanket and towels (exchanged daily). Participants make their own beds.

The apartments offer the privacy, space and quiet surroundings highly valued by all of our guests.

The apartment suites feature:

- Spacious, comfortable living and dining areas, many with large picture windows that let in plenty of natural light
- Most apartments have a kitchen that comes equipped with a sink and refrigerator (the stoves are turned off during the summer months)
- Clean, bright bathrooms shared only by suitemates (up to 6 people)
