

## "Best of Patchwork and Etc." Sampler

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### Supply List:

1. **Sewing machine** and basic sewing supplies (**Please bring your machine's manual**)
2. **Rotary cutter, cutting matt**, and a **see-thru ruler** (a perfect choice is the **Olfa #12** that is 6" x 12"), **pins**, and **100% cotton thread** in a neutral color for piecing.
3. **Black** (or dark) **thread** for blanket stitching
4. Several **#2 pencils** (and pencil sharpener)
5. **Open-toe appliqué foot** (**Bernina #20**)
6. A  $\frac{1}{4}$ " **foot that provides an accurate 1/4" seam allowance** (**Bernina #57**)
7. **Zipper foot** that fits your machine
8. **Scissors** for paper cutting
9. **Small, very sharp scissors** for use in reverse appliqué. (Appliqué "duckbill" scissors can be used but are not essential - **bring only if you already own them. I prefer the Gingher G-5 knife-edge.**)
10. **1/4 yard paper stabilizer** (e.g., **Stitch 'n' Tear™**, **Tear-a-way™**, **Reynolds' Freezer Paper**)
11. **Fabric** - 3 - 5 miscellaneous fat quarters to play and experiment with - include a 3" x 8" piece of muslin. Bring fabrics of varied colors and values, both prints and solids - good contrast is a necessity! You will be making samples for a technique notebook, not for use in a current project. **Bring fabric you feel you can "waste"**. **Heavily spray-starch all fabric.**
12. **Optional:** stiletto; clamp-on lamp; battery operated pencil sharpener
13. **Optional:** cording foot for your machine (#12 on Berninas)
