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Give and Take Appliqué - Ti Leaves

Machine Class

Learn appliqué design with a surprising “two for one” twist, there’s no waste in this technique with fusible web and students choice of fabrics. Find out how to create positive and negative blocks with one design and a range of layout options for exciting design possibilities. Give and Take Appliqué will become an important design concept for future exploration.

Skill Level: Intermediate

Machine Requirements: sewing machine with open toe embroidery foot or foot suitable for machine appliqué/zig zag stitching, also foot for straight stitching with 1/4” seam.

Workshop Supplies:

Fabric: choose subtle prints or textures, batiks work well

Light green fabric four fabrics-1/4 yard each

Dark green fabric: four fabrics-1/4 yard each

For finishing (not needed for class) Backing 1 yard

Binding 1/4 yard

Batting 44” x 26”

Other Supplies:

- Fusible Web (12” wide) 1 1/4 yards
- Thread 60 weight cotton or poly to match appliqué (dark green fabrics)
- Rotary cutting equipment (6 1/2” square and 6” x 12” rulers are recommended) mat and cutter
- Neutral piecing thread
- Basic Sewing Supplies
- Paper and pencil for note taking
