Construction Techniques Using Silk Organza

\$15 Supply fee will include silk organza, handouts, and use of communal supplies.

o Basic Class Supplies:

- Notebook and/or sketchbook
- Pencil

o Basic Sewing Supplies:

- Fabric scissors
- Rotary cutter, gridded ruler, and mat
- Seam ripper
- Extra bobbins
- Extra machine needles suitable for sewing silk (70 sharp)
- Hand sewing needles suitable for use with silk (Quilting between work well)
- Thimble (if you use one)

o Threads – an assortment of content (silk, rayon, cotton) and colors. Thread spools are small and light; err on the side of packing more than you think you'll need and try to find it in your heart to share with others if necessary.

OPTIONAL:

- I will demonstrate some machine methods for sewing silk organza along with hand sewing techniques. You may choose to bring a sewing machine to make sample techniques, or choose instead to only try the hand sewing and no-fuse methods in class. If you bring your sewing machine, pack a machine with which you are familiar. Workshop hours are precious; don't spend it learning how to make a bobbin or sew the blanket stitch on a new machine. Be sure to pack the straight and blanket stitch presser feet, correct plug, foot pedal (don't laugh, it has happened!), and instruction booklet.
